### **Children's Meeting**

All children are welcome to stay with their parents in the Meeting Room during meeting for worship, if that suits them. There is also a Children's Meeting for those aged 10 and younger. While we say it starts at 10 am, in reality it is helpful for parents to bring their children to the Annex (which is located in the grounds of the Meeting House), a few minutes prior to 10 am so that parents may come into meeting for worship on time. Children are brought into the Meeting for Worship during the final 10-15 minutes before 'the rise of Meeting' at 11 am. They are then cared for during notices (until about 11:15). ### Student Strike for Climate Action: A Quaker Response

(Cover page - Quakers in Wanganui join in support of the Student strike)

On the 15th of March, 2019, high school students around the world will strike for Climate Justice. This involves students missing school to make the point that they are very much concerned about the global climate crisis and the lack of action on the part of governments to prevent complete disaster.

The movement was begun by Greta Thunberg of Sweden in August of 2018. Student strikes have spread quickly to include many countries in Europe, North America and Australia; on 30 November, 2018, 15,000 students walked out of class in Australia. The March 15 action will be the largest yet, and it will be followed up by the "Extinction Rebellion" which will involve all kinds of direct action coordinated globally on Monday 15 April 2019. Youth are convinced that the only weapon they have in the struggle to stop global catastrophe within their lifetimes is their non-participation in the usual order of things. On March 1, 2019, student leaders published the following letter (abridged) in the UK Guardian:

"Climate crisis and a betrayed generation...

"We, the young, are deeply concerned about our future. Humanity is currently causing the sixth mass extinction of species and the global climate system is at the brink of a catastrophic crisis. Its devastating impacts are already felt by millions of people around the globe. Yet we are far from reaching the goals of the Paris agreement.

Young people make up more than half of the global population. Our generation grew up with the climate crisis and we will have to deal with it for the rest of our lives. Despite that fact, most of us are not included in the local and global decision-making process. We are the voiceless future of humanity.

We will no longer accept this injustice. We demand justice for all past, current and future victims of the climate crisis, and so we are rising up. Thousands of us have taken to the streets in the past weeks all around the world. Now we will make our voices heard. On 15 March, we will protest on every continent.
